

CHATEAU GRIVIÈRE

This former Lafite-Rothschild vineyard, Chateau Griviere, has produced some of Bordeaux's finest Cru Bourgeois wines for over three centuries. It sits on the highest plateau of the Medoc region. The climate of the region is oceanic, with mild winters and warm dry summers. This vineyard produces the most important Bordeaux varietals, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot. The vineyard has a long policy of minimal intervention and sustainable agriculture to preserve the environment and the rich tastes that make every vintage unique.

| Harvest | Grapes are hand selected in the beginning of October then the wine is aged in oak barrels for 12 months in an underground cellar |
