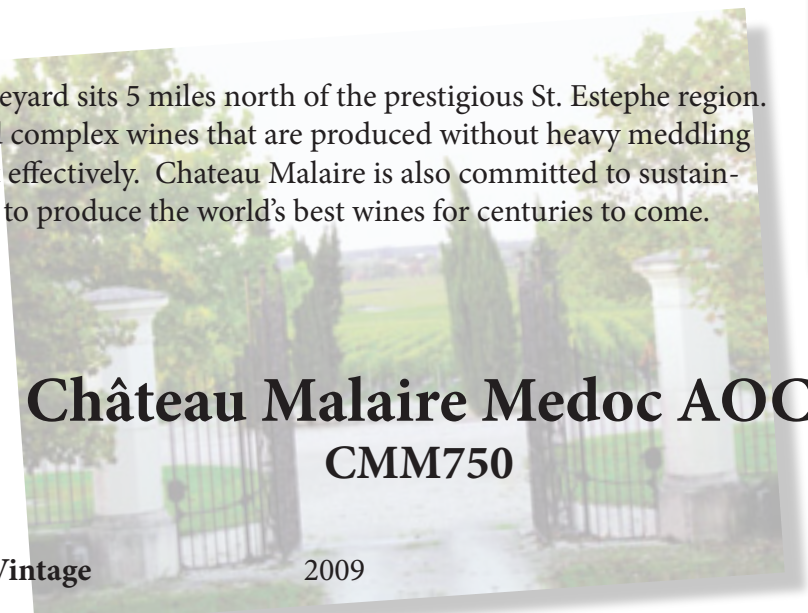


CHATEAU MALAIRE

The limestone-clay based soil delivers rich and complex wines that are produced without heavy meddling to express the terroir and vintage aspects most effectively. Chateau Malaire is also committed to sustainable agriculture to ensure Bordeaux continues to produce the world's best wines for centuries to come.

Color	Profound ruby in color with garnet tints
Average Vine Age	15 years
When to Drink	Enjoyable now, but will improve with age
Tasting Note	On the nose, the attack is fresh and fruity, alluring crushed raspberry and strawberry with notes of plum and cut hay. The palate is frank and supple, showing fine balance on a register of well- ripened red fruits. The lingering finish brings a hint of dry autumn leaves.
Food Pairing	Enjoy with pasta dishes with red sauce and red meats
Harvest	Grapes are hand selected in the beginning of October then the wine aged in stainless steel vats for 18 months then is bottled and aged in an underground cave
Alcohol/Volume	13%
Packaging	Traditional cork closure, 12x750ml pack size
