The Story

Today, the Hex vom Dasenstein vineyard produces some of Germany's best Pinot Noir/Spätburgunder. The town of Kappelrodeck in Germany's Baden area is home to the Hex vom Dasenstein vineyard. The vineyard is named after a witch, who, according to a 1356 legend, used to live in a rock cave in the middle of the vineyard.

The Bottle

The Pinot Noir is bottled in a hand-painted embossed bottle, which depicts the namesake of the vineyard, riding on a goat with her broomstick.

The Wine

The dark ruby red wine combines a fine fruit bouquet with a warm full body. It's ideal drinking temperature is 60° F – 65° F. Vegan.

Food Pairing

Best enjoyed with chicken and mushroom risotto, hearty soups with cheesy toasts, venison stews, pot roasts, squash salads with balsamic vinagraitte, or chicken pot pie.
